HACKETTSTOWN -- Conservationists and adult-beverage enthusiasts teamed up on Saturday for the 2017 Hackettstown Hopped Up Scavenger Pub Crawl.

The event was organized by the New Jersey Highlands Coalition.

Participants spent the better part of the day visiting local pubs, bars and breweries while searching for scavenger hunt clues and checking in on social media.
